First family homes built on CHP land holding

Five new family homes for rent have been built on one of CHP's former parking courts in North West Chelmsford.

The new street - named Fitzroy Terrace - contains five high quality three-bedroom houses built by McCann Homes and have been delivered with support from Chelmsford Borough Council (CBC) and the Housing Corporation. Handed over on July 11th the Mayor of Chelmsford, Councillor Tom Willis, officially opened the scheme recently with CHP Chairman, Martin Dean.

Martin Dean said: "The homes will provide much needed affordable family accommodation within the borough and provides an excellent example of how housing associations, such as CHP, are utilising their existing land holdings to help meet housing needs."

A further eight homes for rent are currently being built for CHP by McCann Homes on two nearby sites. Planning approval for a further 18 homes was recently received for sites in the Broomfield, Great Baddow, Writtle and Melbourne areas, all former CHP garage and infill sites.
